Medals will be awarded based on final scores, and gold medalists will be offered the opportunity to exhibit their wines at the Drink Pink Vino International Rosé Festival on Friday, June 8, 2018 at the Omni Interlocken Resort's Outdoor Pavilion in Broomfield, CO. This will be an extraordinary chance to get local and national media exposure for your wines – expected attendees will include sommeliers, master sommeliers, wine journalists and bloggers, chefs, wine enthusiasts and local media.
